4. **Matters arising from the minutes**

4.1 The request for double yellow on lines on the junction opposite the Gegin Fach was on going.

4.2 The clerk had established that a defibrillator, an external housing unit and installation kit would cost approximately £1500 but it would require a minimal electricity supply to be operational. Agreed to ask the County Council whether it could be connected to a street lamp by the bus shelter in Pontrhydybont.

- 7.1 Final Accounts 2024/25
The Internal Auditor's report confirmed that the 2024-25 accounts were in order and that there were no recommendations for the Council's attention. Following full discussion and inspection of the Annual Return document it was unanimously agreed to accept the report. The Chairman would now certify the Annual Return prior to it being forwarded to the External Auditors. The Community Council were due a Full Audit for 2024-25 – deadline for submission 7 August 2025.
- 7.2 Insurance
Although the Council accepted and paid the renewal quote of £257.60 offered by Zurich for 2025-26, they were informed that they were no longer selling this type of policy and that the cheque sent to them had been destroyed. It was said that they had an alternative policy suitable for smaller to councils but the content needed to be looked at in more detail. It was unanimously agreed to authorise the clerk to purchase a suitable policy with a matter of urgency, Cllr. William Roberts would also assist.
