Gan fod Mr Owen yn bresennol yn yr adeilad gofynnwyd iddo arwyddo ei fod yn dderbyn sedd ar y Cyngor Cymuned ac fe'i gwahoddwyd i ymuno am weddill y cyfarfod.

5. Materion yn codi o'r cofnodion

5.1 Llygredd yn y dŵr wrth Bont Plas Coch – CSYM am ymweld â'r safle ond awgrymwyd hefyd mai Cyfoeth Naturiol Cymru ddylai edrych ar hwn. Cyng. Geraint Owen wedi cytuno i gadw log o unrhyw arogl o'r safle.

6. Ceisiadau Cynllunio

6.1 FPL/2024/ 299 at Rhyd y Bont, Pontrhydybont

Cais llawn i drosi adeilad allanol fferm bresennol yn anecs ategol i'r annedd bresennol ynghyd â ymestyn y cwrtil preswyl a gosod pecyn trin carthffosiaeth a ffos gerrig – dim gwrthwynebiad.

7. Mynediad i draeth Rhoscolyn

Cyflwynwyd llythyr gan CSYM yn cynnig dileu'r llwybr pren oedd wedi'i ddifrodi ac ail-leoli'r amddiffynfeydd creigiau / arfordirol gan ei fod mewn cyflwr gwael ac yn peri risg iechyd a diogelwch i'r cyhoedd. Gan nad oedd gan y Cyngor Sir arian i'w drin a bod amheuaeth am bwy oedd perchennog y tir a phwy fyddai'n gyfrifol petai rywun yn brifo cytunwyd mai cau'r mynediad yn gyfan gwbl fyddai orau.

- 9.1 Archwiliadau Cyfrifon 2022/23 - Nodwyd bod yr Archwilwyr Allanol wedi cymeradwyo'r cyfrifon terfynol a chyhoeddi adroddiad diamod. Er bod dim o'i le, fe nodwyd y canlynol:

Mae'r adroddiadau archwilio mewnol yn awgrymu nad oedd y Cyngor wedi cynnal ei gofnodion cyfrifeg yn llawn fel sy'n ofynnol gan Reoliadau Cyfrifon ac Archwilio (Cymru) 2014. Yn hytrach, mae'n ymddangos mai dim ond ar ddiwedd y flwyddyn y paratowyd y cofnodion cyfrifyddu. Mae'n hanfodol bod y Cyngor yn cadw cofnod o ddydd i ddydd o'i holl dderbynebau a thaliadau fel y nodir yn y Rheoliadau. Bydd hyn yn helpu'r Cyngor i reoli ei gyllid yn iawn. Nid yw maint cymharol fach y Cyngor wedi'i eithrio o'r gofynion statudol i gynnal cofnodion priodol ac i ddiogelu'r arian y mae'n ymddiried ynddo.

- 9.2 Cyfrifon 2024/25 – Nodwyd fod cyfanswm gwariant o £4293.62 i ddiwedd Tachwedd 2024 ond roedd lwfans cynghorwyr, cyflog hanner blwyddyn a mwy o filiau archwilio i ddod. Y rhagolwg oedd, y bydd tan wariant erbyn diwedd o flwyddyn a hynnu yn bennaf am na fu angen talu am gyfieithu yn y misoedd diwethaf.

RHOSCOLYN COMMUNITY COUNCIL

Council Meeting Minutes - 7.00pm. Thursday, 14 November 2024

1. Apologies: Keith Roberts (County Councillor)

2. Declaration of Interest: – none.

3. Vacant Seats:

The Clerk submitted applications from Mr Geraint Owen and Mr Meilir Parry and it was confirmed that both applicants had met the criteria for co-option. The applications were discussed in detail and it was unanimously agreed to co-opt the two on to Rhoscolyn Community Council.

As Mr Owen was present in the building he was asked to sign his 'Acceptance of Office' following which he was invited to join for the remainder of the meeting.

4. Minutes of previous meeting: minutes of 3 October 2024 accepted as correct (prop. Cllr. S. Hanbury, seconding. Cllr. E. Owen).

5. Matters arising from the minutes

5.1 Pollution in the water by Plas Coch Bridge – IOACC agreed to visit the site but it was also suggested that Natural Resources Wales should look at this. Cllr. Geraint Owen agreed to keep a log of any odour from the site.

6. Planning Applications

6.1 FPL/2024/ 299 at Rhyd y Bont, Pontrhydybont

Full application for the conversion of an existing farm outbuilding into an annex ancillary to the existing dwelling together with an extension to the existing residential curtilage, installation of a package treatment plant and soakaway – no objection.

7. Access to Rhoscolyn beach – A letter was submitted by IOACC proposing to remove the damaged boardwalk and reposition the rock / coastal defences as it was in poor condition and posed a health and safety risk to the public. As the County Council had no funds for repairs and there was doubt about who owned the land / path and who would be responsible if anyone was hurt it was agreed that it would be best to close the access altogether.t.

8.3 Holyhead Alliance – Following a recent meeting at Canolfan Gwelfor it was noted that £30,000 was available to share between the communities of Rhoscolyn, Trearddur and Holyhead. Several successful bids had already been submitted by organisations in the Holyhead area. In reality it was considered unlikely that the Rhoscolyn area would benefit from this funding.

8.6 NJC pay rise - it was noted that the clerk was employed on Local Government terms and conditions, the recent negotiated pay rise would result in an increase cost of £104.61 for 2024/25.

8.7 Section 137 spending limit for 2025-26. - Under section 137(3), Community and Town Councils are allowed to bear expenditure for charitable and other purposes specified. The maximum expenditure that can be incurred under section 137(1) and (3) for the 2025-26 financial year, in both cases, will be £11.10 per elector.

9. Financial Matters

Submitted: RFO financial report for the period of 1. 9.2024 to 31.10. 2024) together with bank reconciliations, statements and copies of the accounts.

9.1 Account Audits 2022/23 - It was noted that the External Auditors had approved the final accounts and issued an unqualified report but the following were noted:

The internal audit reports suggest that the Council did not fully maintain its accounting records as required by the Accounts and Audit (Wales) Regulations 2014. Instead, it appears that the accounting records were only prepared at the end of the year. It is essential that the Council keeps a day-to-day record of all its receipts and payments as

set out in the Regulations. This will help the Council manage its finances properly. The Council's relatively small size is not exempt from the statutory requirements to maintain proper records and to protect the funds it trusts.

- 9.2 Accounts 2024/25 – It was noted that the total expenditure to the end of November was £4293.62 but there was still councillors' allowance and six months salary to pay and more audit bills to come. However there was likely to be an underspend by the end of the financial year as there has been no need to pay for translation in recent months.
- 9.3 Financial Year 2025/26 – the clerk would prepare an estimated budget so as to apply for a precept from IOACC in January.
- 9.4 Financial Regulations – agreed to accept the new Financial Regulations introduced by the RFO. These were based on the sample document prepared by NALC / One Voice Wales.
- 9.5 Payments: agreed to pay these:
